- Book Fair -The Executive Board decided to take all of the money in Scholastic Dollars which means we got 50% of profits plus a bonus, totaling \$3121

- We are expecting a significant overage at the end of the year, setting up next year to start with ~ \$4-5000. Compared to two years ago when the starting balance was under \$1000, we have made significant progress with our fundraising.
